

## **Noisy Chooky Cups!**



### **Materials**

1. 1 x Red Plastic Cup
2. 1 x paddle pop stick piece (about a quarter of the normal length)
3. 30cm length of wool
4. Piece of Chux cloth or paper towel folded (approximately 10cm x 10cm)
5. 2 x Funky Eyes
6. 3 x funky feathers
7. Some yellow felt for the beak and chicken legs
8. Scissors
9. PVA Adhesive and/or stapler

### **Directions**

1. Make a small hole in the centre of the base of your cup.
2. Tie your length of string around the middle of the paddle pop stick.
3. Turn the cup upside down and from the inside of the cup, thread one end of the wool through the hole you have made and pull through until the paddle pop stick rests on the top of the upturned cup.
4. Glue eyes and beak to one side of the cup to create a chicken face.
5. Turning the cup upside down again, push the base of your head feathers through the small hole your wool goes through.
6. How to make your new Funky Chicken squeak: Lightly moisten the paper towel. Place the moistened paper towel at the top of the wool (*close to the cup*) and pull down in short strokes. As it slides down the wool, your chook will make chicken sounds...*Bok, bok, Bwwwaaaaarrk!*
